Ministry of Funeral Hospitality
This is the ministry at St Joseph Parish and we would like parishioners to know what is offered with this service.

Luncheons are not a requirement of a Catholic funeral, but a family's choice. Those of us that have been doing this for a lot of years have seen, that at times, the luncheon is a little more than a family needs at this difficult time. Especially with the rising prices of food and the associated dinnerware (i.e. Plates, plastic wear, etc.) it can be burdensome. With that being said, it is perfectly fine to not have a luncheon. If you wish, an alternative would be to have desserts, coffee, and punch. This still offers a time to gather after the funeral.

Luncheons are paid for in full by the family. The parish offers a cold cut menu. For those who want more than what is offered we suggest Donna's Catering. The use of the church basement is of course free.

One of the most difficult things to ask a family member is how many people they are expecting. This is so we can have seating and food to their expectations. It doesn't always work out. Sometimes the guess is too low; other times there is an over abundance of food left over. Again, it is a hard question to ask and expect a family to figure out the count.

As members of the parish you will be called upon to make salads and desserts for luncheons. Thank you for your most gracious help in the past, and for the coming future. It is greatly appreciated.

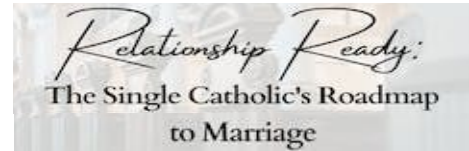
