Cemetery Guide Lines - Decorations

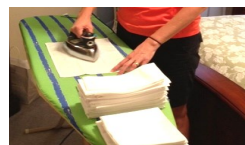
As the weather is getting nicer, people are starting to decorate their loved ones' graves. **There are some changes to the cemetery's rules and regulations to keep in mind.** If you have any questions, please call the parish office or your cemetery representative. Gravesite Adornment: ●Shepard hooks are not allowed on the gravesite. These are dangerous to the people mowing the lawn. They will be removed and dis-posed of if found. ●Solar lights are only allowed in the urn, not directly in the ground. ●There are no fences, landscape stones, rocks, gravel or bark allowed around the headstone. ●No planting of trees or shrubs directly in the ground is permitted. They will be removed by maintenance. ●Burial/casket flowers will be allowed to remain on the gravesite 4 days after burial. After that, they will be removed.

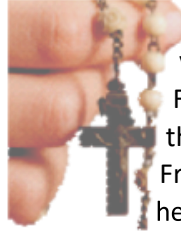
